

## Jesus' Twelve Men Luke 6:12-16

**Jesus chose twelve men to train for the future success of His ministry. How to choose wisely:**

**1. P \_\_\_\_\_ for God's wisdom and insight. (v 12)**

1.1 Prayer is an \_\_\_\_\_ of one's \_\_\_\_\_ on the Father.

1.2 Prayer is an \_\_\_\_\_ of one's \_\_\_\_\_ to God.

**2. P \_\_\_\_\_ only those who already have shown a commitment to spiritual growth. (v 13)**

2.1 A disciple may be a \_\_\_\_\_ learner – a student of Christ.

2.2 A disciple may be a \_\_\_\_\_ follower – a believer in Christ.

2.3 A disciple may be a \_\_\_\_\_ believer – a maturing (not a perfect) servant of Christ.

**3. P \_\_\_\_\_ those who are spiritually humble and willing to pay the cost of training. (v 14-16)**

3.1 \_\_\_\_\_ to doing ministry as ambassadors of Jesus rather than the \_\_\_\_\_ of a title.

- All twelve were \_\_\_\_\_ to be apostles (official representatives).
- All twelve were \_\_\_\_\_ to do ministry. (Mark 3:14-15)

3.2 \_\_\_\_\_ in the Lord's abilities and authority rather than \_\_\_\_\_ in one's own skills. (Matt. 10:1)

- All twelve were citizens of Capernaum/Galilea, not from \_\_\_\_\_ Jerusalem/Judea.
