

## **Warning: Judgement is Coming!**

Luke 12:49-13:9

**God's temporal judgment will affect everyone at the time of its execution.**

### **1. For Jesus' disciples there would be \_\_\_\_\_ between them and unbelieving Jews, not peace. (12:49-53)**

1.1 Jesus desired to \_\_\_\_\_ His work as Messiah for the nation of Israel. (v 49)

- To \_\_\_\_\_ Israel through judgment
- To \_\_\_\_\_ Israel with the promised blessings of the kingdom

1.2 Jesus first had to \_\_\_\_\_ death on the cross to remove the sin barrier and to \_\_\_\_\_ death by His resurrection. (v 50)

1.3 Jesus becomes a point of \_\_\_\_\_ between His disciples and unbelieving Israel within the same family. (v 51-53)

### **2. For disbelieving Israel there would be \_\_\_\_\_ and a \_\_\_\_\_ of the kingdom. (12:54-13:9)**

2.1 Because the nation failed to \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus as its Messiah. (12:54-56)

- The multitudes had the \_\_\_\_\_ to perceive Him as their Messiah based on the evidence already presented.
- The multitudes would not \_\_\_\_\_ Him to be their Messiah.

2.2 Because the nation did not seek \_\_\_\_\_ with God before judgement would come. (12:57-59)

- The multitude needed to make things \_\_\_\_\_ with God, seeking a reduced sentence for their rejection of His Son.
- The multitude would not \_\_\_\_\_ their error concerning Jesus, so the sentence would be more severe.

2.3 Because the nation would not \_\_\_\_\_ of their sins. (13:1-5)

- Premature and unexpected death can and does \_\_\_\_\_ in a sinful world.
- Many unbelieving Jews would \_\_\_\_\_ premature death if there was no national repentance of their rejection.

2.4 Because the nation lacked the proper \_\_\_\_\_. (13:6-9)

- God in His mercy had given the nation \_\_\_\_\_ time during Jesus' ministry to produce the fruit of repentance.
- God in His mercy would give the nation \_\_\_\_\_ time in the early church before severely judging Israel.
