4. What would you say in a Gospel presentation to an unsaved individual, especially to provide a complete and accurate message?
5. Is there anything a believer could do that would cause him to lose his salvation?
6. Is it possible for a believer to live carnally, apostatize, or engage in egregious sin indefinitely?
7. Did Christ die for all of humanity or just a select group?
8. What is Spirit baptism, and how does one receive it?
9. When did the church officially begin in Scripture?
10. What is the church's mission, and how should a local church conduct its ministries and services in pursuit of that mission?
11. What role, if any, should humanitarian work play in the church's mission?
12. Can women be pastors or teach and exercise authority over men in the church?
13. Do you believe God is granting the miraculous gifts of healing, tongues, and prophecy today?
14. What is the purpose of water baptism, and who should receive it?
15. What is the purpose of the Lord's Supper, and who should partake of it?
16. Does God have a role for national Israel in the future, and how does Israel relate to the church?
17. Is Christ's kingdom spiritual or earthly, and when did/does it arrive?
18. What is the Rapture, and when does it take place in relation to the Tribulation?
19. Is it ever appropriate to alter the meaning of Scripture to contextualize it to various cultures?
20. Is the LGBTQ(etc.) movement compatible with the Christian life, and how should the church interact with those involved in that lifestyle?
21. To what local church on the mission field are you connected, and how do you remain accountable to them?
